Dear Wallace family,

This is the time of year that our staff and ministry leaders are working on budgets and calendars for 2023. Each year we go through a planning process called OGAPs. OGAPs stands for Objectives, Goals, Action Plans. We begin by stating our objectives. How will this event or initiative fit in with our mission to be disciples and make disciples? If there is no clear objective, then we shouldn't spend our time and resources doing it. Next, we set goals. What are you trying to accomplish through this event or initiative? Goals

require us to determine whether we hit the mark or not. Finally, we develop an action plan. The action plan puts details to our plans. What resources will you need for this event or initiative? What meeting space or budget will be required? As we gather all of this information from our staff and ministry leaders, we are able to build our budget and calendar for the year.

After the conclusion of each event, the leaders fill out an evaluation form. They assess whether the event or initiative accomplished the objectives and goals. They measure whether the action plan worked or not. It could be that the event was planned for outside and the weather didn't cooperate. It could be that the outreach wasn't effective. On the evaluation form, leaders decide whether this is an event that should be repeated the next year, or tweaked some, or scrapped altogether.

Why am I sharing this information with you? Because I want you to understand the process our church uses to plan for the future. I hope this helps you to see how we focus on our mission and try to be as efficient and effective as we can with the resources that God has given our church. Mostly, I want you to pray for our church during this process. Pray for the Lord to give guidance for the future, creativity in developing ministries, courage to make difficult decisions, and unity as we forge ahead. Thank you for all that you do to support the Lord's work at WMBC!
