Dear Wallace family,

What an incredible response last Sunday as we committed to pray for and reach out to our "ones" leading up to Easter. We are praying for Easter to be "The Greatest Weekend." We are studying the final days of Jesus' life in the upcoming weeks, culminating in the resurrection account on Easter Sunday. These messages are challenging as we consider who Jesus is and what He has done for us! It inspires us to give our all to worship and serve Him.

As we prepare for Easter, there are two things that I am asking for you to do:

1. Prepare your heart. Take time over the next few weeks to read through the Gospel accounts of the last week of Jesus' life. Spend time reflecting on God's Word and meditating on what it means in your life. Make time for extended times of prayer and fasting. Ask God to work in your life and grow you over this Easter season.
2. Invite. Make plans to invite your "one" to join you for Easter worship. Invite cards will be available at the Welcome Center over the next several weeks for you to distribute to your friends, neighbors, and co-workers. The Wallace congregation's goal is for 2,000 people in worship, with a total of 2,500 for the entire Wallace family. If we are to reach these goals, we must be serious about inviting people to church. As a reminder, these goals are not about bragging about numbers—it is about many people hearing the gospel and worshipping God. That is our goal.
