Formerly known as "The Source," Wuzhou's Gathering Place is a renovated space for gathering and fellowship on Sundays and Wednesdays. Why Wuzhou? This was the city where Dr. Bill Wallace served as an IMB missionary in China. The new space will have pictures and artifacts to learn more about Bill Wallace and missions. It is also the place for you to get coffee, catch up with friends, and meet new guests. We will no longer be providing free coffee in the atrium. A cup of coffee at Wuzhou's Gathering Place will cost \$3/cup or a pre-paid punch card for 10 cups for \$25. The proceeds will go to a fund to scholarship our church members to go on mission trips. You will still be able to purchase resources there, such as books and Wallace merchandise as well. Wuzhou's Gathering Place will soon become one of your favorite fellowship spots on campus!

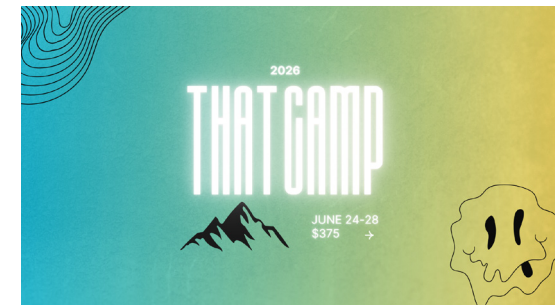
Dear Wallace family,
