Dear Wallace family,

It is hard to believe that it has been a year since we looked at our first pictures of what the new west wing children's area could look like if we completely reconstructed that area. It has been a long and bumpy road to get architect drawings complete, transition plans created and approved, City of Knoxville codes and permits approval and required changes incorporated. Along the way, we have been able to get a few things done:

- Flooring replacement: gym entry, ramp, upstairs classrooms
- Atrium restroom renovation
- Glass wall in upper office balcony for increased sound proofing
- Roof replacement for Gym & Student Building, reseal of Atrium roof
- Baptistry reseal and refinish
- Relocating Mission Wall in Atrium

And we have these projects in progress:

- Final architect plans sent to City of Knoxville for approval, working through revisions
- Working through Contractor Bid process
- Preparing transitional childcare space to be used during construction
- New digital sound board installed with new speakers ordered for the Worship Center
- Two new rooftop HVAC units for Worship Center have been ordered, delivery by August
- Legacy Hall is under construction
- Back entrance ADA ramp work has begun. Entrance and some parking will be unavailable until mid-March

Finding a qualified contractor has been really challenging. There are lots of construction projects in our area needing to get done and contractors have plenty of business to choose from while being affected by the labor shortage. Please pray that God will provide the right contractor for us and that we will be able to start construction soon.
