Dear Wallace family,

We are speeding toward 2025 and I wanted to share with you an update on our 2025 vision. The Lord put in our hearts a huge vision that only He could accomplish a few years ago. We have been praying and working toward these goals over the past few years, even through the wildness of COVID. We have accomplished some of the goals, made great progress toward others, and still have some work to do on some. Here are our goals and where we stand:

. 2000 average worship attendance

Prior to COVID, our church was averaging around 1200 in worship. COVID drastically changed worship attendance and we have had to build back over the last few years. We are now consistently having close to 1200 each week. We have room to grow!

- 2. 4 physical campuses with a language congregation on each campus We currently have 3 physical campuses with a language congregation on 2 of them. This summer we added Riverview Baptist Church as a 3rd campus and the Romanian Baptist Church as the language congregation on the Wallace campus. We are praying about launching Vista Rio as another Spanish congregation on the Riverview campus in 2024. We are well on the way to reaching this goal!
- 3. 50 local mission engagements per month
  As E-teams continue to grow, and as our various ministries are reaching out into the
  community, we are exceeding 50 local mission engagements each month. Praise the Lord!
- Baptize 100 people per year
   In 2023, our church baptized 57 people! We praise the Lord for every single person who comes to faith in Him. That is why we desire to continue to be faithful to share the gospel.

The first half of 2024, we will have a sermon series through the book of Romans called

"Tell the World" that will challenge us to share our faith. We have work to do!

5. Support 2 NAMB church plants

As we began this vision, we supported Reality Church in Miami, FL. As they have grown and become self-supporting, we have transitioned to help others. We are currently working with Revive City Church in Cincinnati, OH, Abiding Church in Los Angeles, CA, and Joseph and Carissa Smyly as they are planting in Montana soon. We have surpassed our goal and are making a difference to plant churches in areas where churches are desperately needed!

6. Adopt a UPG on every inhabited continent

We are currently partnering with IMB missionaries to reach unreached peoples in Germany (Europe), the Philippines (Asia), Indonesia (Oceania), and Mexico (North America). We are praying about potential partnerships for Africa and South America in the future. We are two-thirds of the way toward reaching this goal, and we are making an eternal difference in places with little to no access to the gospel.

When we set these goals several years ago, I became so excited about what God had put in our hearts and minds. I remember thinking, "If our church even comes close to these goals, imagine what that church would be like!" I still feel this way. It is incredible to witness how God has been good and faithful to our Wallace family. I am so excited to be part of such an amazing church. Let us continue to pray and work for the Lord and His kingdom. Let us work diligently to reach these 2025 vision measurables to the glory of God!

Mark Clifton, the Director of Church Revitalization for our North American Mission Board, recently observed that: "Southern Baptist weekly worship attendance was 6.2 million in 2009. In 2022 the weekly attendance was 3.8 million,. a decline of 40% in 13 years. No doubt Covid 2021 and in some cases into 2022 had a huge impact on these numbers."
